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ELECTIVE CLERKSHIP/ROTATION/INTERNSHIP/PRACTICAL TRAINING AT MNH

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Muhimbili National Hospital offers elective clerkship/rotation/internship or practical training to Medical, Nursing and other biomedical students in the course of their studies. Institutions that wish to regularly bring elective students to MNH should sign a MoU with the hospital management. Students are allowed to do practical training or a Research project depending on individual's choice.

Apply preferably 3 months before the intended date of beginning your elective period. All applications must be accompanied by a letter from the Dean/Principal stating that the student is scientifically and socially capable of following the elective successfully.

Clinical students should be in their 4th or 5th year of the course or residents. Students should indicate if possible the hospital/department of their choice and the duration. Students have to stay for the whole period of elective studies.

An occasional student will be discontinued on the following grounds:

- Any serious breach of Hospital regulations
- Abscondment
- Irregular attendance

PAYMENTS

Local students

Undergraduate Students

- Registration fee TSHs. 100,000/
- Tuition/Mentorship fees TSHs. 50,000/week
- Research supervision TSHs. 35,000/week

Postgraduate students

- Registration fee TSHs 100,000/
- Supervision fee per week TSHs. 100,000/-

International students (*will pay fees in foreign currency*)

Under graduate students

- Registration fee USD 100
- Tuition fee USD 50 per week
- Research supervision fee USD 35 per week (for research students only)

Postgraduate students

- Registration fee USD 100
- Supervision fee per week USD 100
- Research supervision fee USD 35 per week (for research students only)

Supervisors/Mentors will be assigned to lead and advise students during the whole period of stay in respective departments. Teaching, Research and Consultancy Unit will coordinate all the activities.

Ideally, medical students coming for clerkships should bring with them a minimum set of equipment e.g. blood pressure machine, white coat, tendon hammer, stethoscope etc.

The hospital will not provide accommodation or living allowance rather it offers simple and comfortable accommodation in the hospital flats located about 400 metres from the main hospital for US\$ 15 per night. If you require a certificate of attendance or have forms that require signatures, please inform us at the time of your registration. Submit your forms at least a three days before you intended day of completion of your elective period. Remember, this is the teaching hospital and **NOT** University hospital. Signatures and stamps will be from hospital and **NOT** otherwise.

RESEARCH PROJECTS

Students coming for research projects should submit their research proposals together with the application forms to allow time for scrutiny and institutional ethical clearance. The Hospital will identify a supervisor while a student is in Tanzania.
